# 19th Sunday of Ordinary Time 13 August 2023

One of the disadvantages of taking annual leave in July and then coming back in August without a working email system ... is that I completely lost track of current affairs! Apparently World Youth Day was running last week, and I totally forgot about it!

One of the parishioners expressed disappointment that there was no mention of the event last week. And because the Solemnity of the Assumption will occur this Tuesday (15<sup>th</sup> August), this reflection will be spent focussing upon that particular event. Hopefully there is nothing exciting happening next week, so I can eventually get round to talking about World Youth Day. I am hoping to ask one of the families who attended to give us a bit of a reflection upon their World Youth Day experiences in Portugal.

In regards to the Solemnity of the Assumption this coming Tuesday, (15<sup>th</sup> August), I would be failing in my responsibilities as parish priest if I did not remind parishioners that the Assumption is one of the two Holy Days of Obligation that we observe here in Australia. The discipline of the Church is that we observe a Holy Day of Obligation the same we observe our Sunday obligation to attend Mass:

1) by attending the celebration of Mass with faith and devotion

2) and we abstain from paid labour (so – ideally – we should not be working on either Christmas Day or the Assumption. However, God knows that we do not live in a perfect world ... that it is not always possible for Catholics to take time off work on the Assumption).

This year we will have three Masses at St Joseph's for the Assumption: 9am, 11am, and 7pm.

Thanks to the generosity of our resident musicians and singers, we will have music available at both the 9am and 7pm Masses (so Mass will take around the same time as a Sunday service).

In previous years, the early Mass was held with the children of St Joseph's school present. The 11am and 7pm were more for the benefit of the parish community. Due to a full school program on Tuesdays this year, it is not possible for the St Joseph's students to attend Mass together as a school community on the feast of the Assumption. This does give me an opportunity to examine the whole situation, and whether I still need to run the three Masses on the 15<sup>th</sup> August into the future.

So I will be keeping close watch on Mass numbers this Tuesday, to see if all three Masses are still viable and necessary. I would also like to hear some feedback from parishioners regarding whether it is necessary for us to have a Vigil Mass for the Assumption (a Mass that is held on the evening of the day before, just like we do at Sunday Mass).

Speaking of which ... at the last Parish Pastoral Council meeting, it was recommended that the Suggestions Box be restored up the back of the Church. So from this weekend, the Suggestions Box will be available. Please remember, it is only the suggestions that have the person's name and contact number that will be considered (that way, we know who to congratulate if something goes well, and who to blame if it all falls apart!).


