Confirmation (along with Baptism and Holy Orders) is one of the seven sacraments of the Church that, when validly received, the sacrament can never be repeated again. The celebration of the sacrament of Confirmation is an ideal opportunity to remind parishioners about the seven gifts of the Holy Spirit.

Wisdom

An illumination of the mind, enabling a grasp of the ultimate realities of God and divine things.

Understanding

To see the truth, meaning and implications of what God has revealed (for instance, through the Scriptures).

Knowledge

To see created things in their right relation to God (for example, family life in God's presence).

Counsel

To perceive the actions we must do in particular situations.

Fortitude

To have strength and confidence to accomplish difficult actions.

Piety

To have a familial respect for God, other persons, and holy things.

Fear of the Lord


To have a holy fear of offending God because of our love for God.

In confirmation, the candidates receive the GIFT (singular) of the Holy Spirit. The Holy Spirit than bestows these seven GIFTS (plural) to each confirmand, each in relation to their capacity and ability to receive them.
