Last week, I received some news about Niamh that upset me, made me dwell on a future without her and led me into feelings of anxiety and helplessness.

Both of Niamh's Physio's have noticed a "change" in her physical abilities, a downturn in what she can do. I have noticed this myself, but chose to pretend it wasn't happening and everything was going along well.

One of the Physio's recommended X-rays to see if there were some issues in her hips and legs. Knowing what I do about GM1 Gangliosidosis, I can recognise that the change in her abilities is the progression of the disease and that's what led to my feelings of dread and fear about the situation. That this is GM1, and that Niamh will continue to regress and lose all the abilities that she has.



The fear of bad news can be overwhelming, and lead to thoughts of worst case scenarios, despair and misery.

Minimising that pain and hiding it are 2 things I've become very good at. In order to keep my faith strong, I have needed to be honest in my doubts and express this to God. Prayers that express my vulnerability will lead me to a better relationship with Him.



Believing that God chose Niamh and I for each other allows me to draw on His strength and His belief in me. I need to continue to work on my relationship with God and understand His plan for both me and Niamh. I need to recognise that faith is stronger than fear – that faith is real, and that I need to trust and believe even when I am afraid.


