The Epiphany of the Lord—8 January 2023



This week we celebrate the Epiphany—the revelation of Jesus as God—and as a part of this observance, the Magi bringing the gifts of gold, frankincense and myrrh, gifts fit for a King, to the baby Jesus. We also celebrate the life of Pope Emeritus Benedict XVI. There is beauty in the harmony of this—as we come to know the true value of the Nativity with the acknowledgment of Jesus as King, both divine and human, we celebrate the gift of Benedict who through

his Papacy and enrichment of Theology, reminds us of the meaning of the symbols of the Epiphany and the person of Jesus.

Requiem Mass for Pope Emeritus Benedict XVI

It has been a while since we last had the death of a Pope. The last time was in 2005 with the death of Pope St John Paul the Great. The last time a Pope Emeritus died was in 1417, when Pope Gregory XII died around two years after he voluntarily resigned from office. It is certainly the first time I have experienced this event since being ordained to the priesthood over ten years ago. This required me to wait until information how to properly conduct any liturgical celebrations arrived from the Archdiocese.

The information arrived on Tuesday. In consequence, the usual 9am Saturday morning Mass held at St Joseph's on the 14th January will be celebrated as a Requiem Mass, praying for the repose of Pope Emeritus Benedict XVI's soul, for the comforting of those who mourn him, and for the unity of Christians.



This is one of the strengths and beauties of the Catholic faith – we can still pray for the deceased even when the body is not physically present. This tradition is poignantly captured by St Monica, who – when her own death was approaching – instructed her son, St Augustine: "Bury this body where it lies. But remember me when you come to the altar of the Lord."
