The Most Holy Body and Blood of Christ A

11 June 2023

The 3rd of March this year (2023) marked the 100 year anniversary of the official opening and blessing of Corpus Christi Seminary – the regional seminary for the Archdioceses of Melbourne, Hobart and Adelaide, and the Dioceses of Ballarat, Sandhurst, and Sale.

The Regional Bishops of the time were blessed with foresight to name the seminary after the central mystery of the Catholic faith, the Body of Christ – the Eucharist, which Vatican II called the “source and summit of the Christian life.” (Lumen Gentium 11)

Corpus Christi is the oldest seminary still operating in Australia that has kept its original name. Although the name has remained the same, the location of the seminary has changed over the years, operating in Werribee (1923-1973), Glen Waverley (1960-1973), Clayton (1973-1999), and it's current home in Carlton (2000 onwards).

The motto of Corpus Christi seminary is “De Te Vivere,” which comes from the fifth verse of the ancient Latin prayer, Adoro Te Devote, written by St Thomas Aquinas:

O memoriale mortis Domini,
Panis vivus vitam praestans homini:
Praesta meae menti DE TE VIVERE,
Et te illi semper dulce sapere.

As my Latin has and always will be atrocious, I will turn to the beautiful translation of Gerard Manley Hopkins:

O thou our reminder of Christ crucified,
Living Bread, the life of us for whom he died
Lend this life to me then: feed and feast my mind,
There be thou the sweetness man was meant to find.

You are warmly invited to the 3pm Holy Hour we will hold on Sunday 11th June to honour the feast of Corpus Christi.
