The Most Holy Trinity A 4 June 2023

On the Sunday after Pentecost, we celebrate the Solemnity of the Most Holy Trinity or Trinity Sunday. From childhood, we make the Sign of the Cross “in the name of the Father, the Son and the Holy Spirit”, and we are also baptised with the same words. We believe that the one true God exists as three Divine Persons – the Father, the Son and the Holy Spirit.



God the Father - the creator and supporter of all things

God the Son – the incarnation of God as a human being, Jesus Christ, on Earth

God the Holy Spirit - the power of God which is active in the world, drawing people towards God

The Catechism of the Catholic Church tells us that the Most Holy Trinity is the central mystery of our faith and life. “It is the mystery of God himself. It is therefore the source of all the mysteries of faith, and the light that enlightens them. It is the most fundamental and essential teaching in the hierarchy of the truths of faith” (CCC 234) A little confusing, yes, but a reinforcement of the importance of the Trinity as the foundation of all that we believe in. God is One, yet shows himself to us in different ways with the purpose being love and charity, to each other and ourselves. What we want in our lives, being unity, joy, harmony and positive relationships, is what God is, as the Father, the Son and the Holy Spirit.

The readings on Trinity Sunday tell us that since creation, God intended his words and works to prepare us for the mystery of one God in three persons. The sign of the cross is a profession of our faith, and the words we say are an abbreviated form of the Apostles Creed - showing our belief in the Father, the Son and the Holy Spirit - The Most Holy Trinity.
