REQUIREMENTS FOR BAPTISM

Please find enclosed a Baptismal Form, for you to complete, and return to St. Paul's Parish, at the address given above.

Baptisms are celebrated at St. Paul's Church, **only** on Sundays at 12.00 pm., outside of mass. The Celebration of Baptism will take around 20 to 25 minutes. **This is the set time, so please be punctual.**

Once I have received the enclosed completed form, then, you need to attend to **one** of the following Baptism Preparation meetings, if you are baptizing your child for the first time. Baptism Preparation meetings take place on the third Thursday of every month at 7.30 pm., beginning on 15th Feb, 2018, 15th March, 19th April, 17th May, 21st June, 19th July, 16th August, 20th Sept, 18th October, and 15th November 2018.

Preferably, both godparents are catholic; according to Church Law (Canon Law) at least one godparent has to be a confirmed catholic, if the other godparent is from other Christian denomination. They are not to be less than sixteen years of age.

In the case of parents wishing to baptize their child at St Paul's, but are residing in another parish, a written approval from the parish priest of the other parish has to be presented with the Baptismal Form. Church Law states that after six months that a catholic has taken up residence, the parish in that territory becomes his parish; so a written approval from the parish priest is needed.

A Certificate of Baptism will be given to the parents after the celebration of Baptism. A donation of \$100 to the church is greatly appreciated.
