Because that is what he has done: he has taken us out of the power of darkness and created a place for us in the kingdom of the Son that he loves, and in him, we gain our freedom, the forgiveness of our sins. He is the image of the unseen God and the first-born of all creation, for in him were created all things in heaven and on earth: everything visible and everything invisible, Thrones, Dominations, Sovereignities, Powers – all things were created through him and for him. Before anything was created, he existed, and he holds all things in unity. Now the Church is his body, he is its head. 'You got the same sentence as he did, but in our case we deserved it: we are paying for what we did. But this man has done nothing wrong. Jesus,' he said 'remember me when you come into your kingdom.' 'Indeed, I promise you,' he replied 'today you will be with me in paradise.'

REFLECTION: "The Remembrance We Desire"

**Jesus, remember me when you come into your kingdom.
Luke 23:42**

Luke's Gospel is the only one that recounts this poignant scene involving a criminal we sometimes call "The Good Thief." On the surface, this looks like an eleventh-hour deathbed repentance, but it is so much more. Yes, this is a dying man who, in his final hours, is confronted by his own transgressions and brokenness. At the same time, this is a person noticing, perhaps for the first time in his life, what it means to belong to the kingdom of right relationship, of justice, of compassion. He sees this kingdom embodied in Jesus, the person hanging beside him, the person gazing back at him with welcome. All this man asks is to be remembered. This, I believe, is our desire as well: to be at home and forever welcomed into the heart of the Holy One. May it be so.
