REFLECTION: "Gaining Peace Without Knowing"

Jesus said to his disciples: "I have much more to tell you, but you cannot bear it now. But when he comes, the Spirit of truth, he will guide you to all truth." John 16:12-13

There is so much God wants to tell us about himself. He comes to us as Father, Son and Holy Spirit—three persons—one in being, existing from the beginning to the end of time. The Trinity comforts, saves, creates, dies and rises. Who can hold these realities?

Just as God told Moses, "...for no one can see me and live" (Exodus 33:20), we spend our whole lives preparing for our ultimate union with God.

I think about this sometimes as I go about my day, driving my kids around, going to the grocery, tending to my work—even the most banal and stressful moments are a participation in the mystery of God. I cannot bear to know right now how these seemingly meaningless actions unfold in the divine drama. I pray to be at peace with not knowing.

NEWS IN THE ARCHDIOCESE

POPE FRANCIS OFFICIALLY APPROVED A CHANGE TO THE MOST FAMOUS PRAYER IN CHRISTIANITY.

It's the prayer Jesus taught his followers to pray and one of the few things that unites 2.2 billion Christians across the globe. But the Holy See's May 22 approval adjusting The Lord's Prayer, widely known among the faithful as the "Our Father," has been years in the making, U Catholic reported.

The Catholic leader changed the phrase "lead us not into temptation" to "**do not let us fall into temptation**," as mentioned in the gospel of Matthew 6:13, because the original translation implies that God induces temptation. The change, officials said, is closer to the original intent of the prayer.

"I am the one who falls; it's not him pushing me into temptation to then see how I have fallen," Francis explained to Italian broadcasters about the phrase change. "A father doesn't do that, a father helps you to get up immediately. It's Satan who leads us into temptation, that's his department."

"He's saying the translation isn't good because God never makes us fall or never leads us into temptation, he actually allows us to be tempted, but we have to make a choice,"

Francis also approved changes to The Gloria from "Peace on earth to people of good will" to "**Peace on Earth to people beloved by God.**"
