

Third Sunday in Ordinary Time (Year B)

Sunday, 21st January 2024

Dear parishioners of Corio and Lara, in this first newsletter for 2024 I would like to take the opportunity to introduce myself to you more fully.

Prior to my appointment as Administrator of Corio Lara Parish, I could count the number of times I have visited Geelong on one hand! I am the eldest of three sons to John and Fran. I spent my childhood and teenage years in Melbourne's north-eastern suburbs. Growing up, we moved between Eltham, Bundoora, Macleod and Greensborough. I completed my primary schooling at St Martin of Tours in Rosanna and my secondary schooling at the nearby Viewbank College. During these years, I also studied the Viola and played cricket for Macleod and Ivanhoe cricket clubs. I was an active member of my local parish and altar-served regularly at Mass.

In this Sunday's Gospel, the Lord calls Simon Peter, Andrew, James and John to be his disciples and first priests. Jesus comes to them in the midst of their daily lives and says simply, "Follow me." That invitation first echoed in my heart when I was in grade six. I was serving at Mass and, as the priest elevated the Sacred Host at the Consecration, a question formed in my mind: "I wonder if I could do that?" Instinctively, I sensed that this was a thought introduced by God. By His grace, He drew my attention to the beauty and mission of the Catholic priesthood. He helped me realise that this vocation was a possibility for me, despite my unworthiness.

There are many stories about the years of discernment that followed, and over time I look forward to sharing them with you. The main point is that I never said no to the possibility of the priesthood. In prayer, I surrendered to God's will and resolved that, if He made it clear to me that the priesthood was His will for me, then I would say yes.

I completed year twelve in 2009 and was accepted into Law/Arts at La Trobe University. I deferred that course and eventually abandoned it because I was also admitted to Corpus Christi College as a student for the priesthood at the beginning of 2010. After seven and a half years of formation, I was ordained a priest by Archbishop Hart on the 24th of June 2017, the Solemnity of the Nativity of Saint John the Baptist. On my ordination card I placed the words of Saint the Baptist: "He must increase, I must decrease." This phrase captures the essence of the priesthood. I am not a priest for me. I am a priest for you and for Jesus. My mission is to continue Jesus' work of bringing God to humanity and humanity to God. The tools of this mission are the sacraments, the teaching of the Catholic faith, and the forming of a vibrant community of grace.

After my ordination, I served as assistant priest in Box Hill (2017-2020), Altona Meadows (2020), Melton South and Bacchus Marsh (2020-2022), and Keilor Downs (2022-2023). Through the long journey of discernment, formation, and priestly ministry, the good God has led me here, to the parish of Corio and Lara. I am grateful to Archbishop Comensoli for entrusting me with this responsibility and to you for your incredibly warm welcome. Please pray for me as I will pray for you.
