

Fourth Sunday in Ordinary Time (Year B)

Sunday, 28th January 2024

This Sunday marks the completion of my fourth week as Administrator of Corio Lara Catholic Parish. What a four weeks! Your warm welcome and offers of hospitality have helped me to begin to feel more settled. Already I have been able to visit a number of parishioners for coffee or meals and I am looking forward to many more such visits in the months ahead. I have always found it very pastorally beneficial to visit parishioners in their homes. The few minutes we have after Sunday Masses are rarely enough to get to know each other properly. If you would like me to visit your home for a meal or house blessing, don't hesitate to speak to me after Mass or to contact the Parish Office.

Since the Parish Office reopened two weeks ago, Jasna, Gudrun, Deacon Royden and I have done a power of work.

We are ready to launch an under 18s youth group from Sunday 18th February. The youth group is for secondary-school-aged parishioners and will meet fortnightly on Sunday evenings from 6.00pm-8.30pm. The youth group will be organised around three key aims: prayer, formation and friendship.

Three people will commence an abbreviated RCIA course from Sunday 4th February. RCIA (Rite of Christian Initiation for Adults) is the name for the formation course for adults who wish to become Catholic. The three people who will be part of our course have all come through an Alpha Experience last year. Deacon Royden and Gudrun will be running the parish's next Alpha course beginning on 12th February.

During the week, I met with Bill Geerts, the parish's bingo coordinator. Bill confirmed to me that bingo will not be resuming this year. Over the next couple of weeks, I will arrange a suitable acknowledgement for the service that Bill and his team have rendered to the parish and the community.

Over the last two weeks I have also met with Maria Scala, principal of St Francis Xavier Primary School, and Natalie Heard, principal of St Anthony of Padua Primary School. I am looking forward to visiting both schools on a regular basis, beginning this coming week as students and staff return from their Christmas holidays.

I met with Gerard Rowan last week to hear about the progress of the new parish website. Gerard's work and generosity will provide a fresh, functional and engaging digital presence for the parish. I am optimistic that we will be able to launch the new website by Easter. The existing website will continue to be updated until then: www.pol.org.au/corio.

It is my intention to meet with the Parish Mission Team and Parish Finance Committee within the next two to three weeks to begin planning for the rest of the year.

Finally, I have been brought up to speed on the stewardship renewal campaign that was conducted towards the end of last year. The pledges you have made are remarkable. Given Fr Daryl's unexpected transfer, we are only now able to process those pledges. The pledges will be processed on Saturday 3rd February. Please be available that day to take a phone call from one of our team, who will confirm your pledge amount and banking details.
