Going to Hospital?

Here are some tips for parishioners:

1.Before operations or serious procedures, ask your parish priest to anoint you before you go to hospital. (Our hospital chaplains have to respond to



emergencies, but we can all help them with a little forethought).

2. If you are taken to emergency in a serious condition, your relatives should ask the hospital staff to contact the priest who is chaplain to the hospital.

3. If admitted to a <u>public hospital</u> make sure your admission form records that you are a Catholic. The Pastoral Care team will ensure that you receive the Eucharist.

4. If you are admitted to a <u>private hospital</u>, please record that you would like a priest or member of the Pastoral Care team to visit. (If you do not make this request, the pastoral care practitioners and the chaplains will not be told that you are a patient).
