PARISH FINANCE REPORT for year ending 31st December, 2023.

Total Income was \$228,760 - \$35,574 better than the year to date budget.

The Income is from -Thanksgiving, services fees eg Baptisms, Weddings & Funerals. Included in this figure is the donation of \$10,835 for the cost of the air conditioning.

• **Expenses** were \$210,993 - \$17,475 above the year year to date budget.

The Expenses include the Archdiocese Levy, insurance, interest on the debt, and repairs and maintenance.

- * The Income of \$228,760 less the Expenses of \$210,993 leaves a **Surplus** of \$17,768.
- * The main bank account is down \$16,000 at the end of December 2023 from December 2022.


