CHILD SAFETY - OVERVIEW

At our Parish we hold the care, safety and wellbeing of children and young people as a central and fundamental responsibility of our parish. Our commitment is drawn from the teaching and mission of Jesus Christ, with love, justice and sanctity of each human person. For our parish to be a child safe parish, we have established a child safety committee and this committee has attended meetings given by Catholic Archdiocese to inform themselves on how best to make our parish child safe. A child safe policy has been established and is available for all parishioners to view on the parish website. We have a Code of Conduct Statement with an acknowledgement that is required to be signed by all parishioners involved in any activity at the parish. We have set procedures and methods of reporting in case of any suspected child abuse. We have also established a risk management checklist for all ministry groups to review at every meeting. Child safety is a very serious matter and should be included in all parish discussions and meetings on how best to minimise any child's risk in feeling safe at all times. Child Safety is a partnership we will all need to be involved in.
